On behalf of the City of Pierre, welcome to the 2026 South Dakota Class A 14U State Baseball Tournament! We're excited to host players, coaches, families, and fans from across the state. If you love baseball, you've come to the right place.

Tournament games are being played at Hyde Stadium and Kelley Field. Hyde Stadium is also home to the Oahe Zap, Pierre's collegiate summer baseball team competing in the Independence League.



While you're in Pierre, I encourage you to explore other areas of the community. In Griffin Park, we have a brand new outdoor pool featuring a lazy river, multiple slides, diving boards, and two pools. The Cultural Heritage Center just went under a 3 year remodel, and has officially re-opened their doors. Lastly, the Capital Building and Plaza is always a historical stop. Pierre has a lot to offer,

You can also pick up the Trail of Governors right outside the gates of Hyde Stadium. Former Governor Joe Foss is standing at the corner of Ree and Capitol. There are 30 more life-size statues along the Trail that tracks from the Capitol campus to our Historic Business District. Along the way, you can also find a host of restaurants and watering holes featuring everything from signature cocktails to barbeque and authentic Mexican and Asian fare to steak and fine Italian dining.

If you have time to explore a little farther, head to our beautiful Missouri River waterfront. Miles of paved trails connect Pierre and Fort Pierre, offering scenic views and access to many of our recreational amenities, including parks, pickleball and tennis courts, a skate park, swim beach, and more. Our newest recreational feature, the Missouri River Overlook Trail, offers a unique hiking and biking experience with scenic overlooks that showcase some of the best views of the Missouri River Valley. It's a great way to experience Pierre's natural beauty.

HYDE STADIUM

Hyde Stadium was built in 1935 with funding and assistance from Charles L. Hyde family, Pierre American Legion Post 8, the City of Pierre, and the Federal Emergency Relief Administration, a New Deal program that tried to help ease the nation through the Great Depression. The grandstand was added in 1940 by the City of Pierre and the National Youth Administration, another New Deal Program.

Hyde Stadium has been the home field for generation of Pierre American Legion baseball teams, including state champions in 1935, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1967, 1968, and 2017. Pierre's Teener teams won state titles in 1964, 1966, 1986, 1994, and 2012. The 1964 Teener team under Coach Don Kortan advanced to the Nation VFW Teener Tournament in Hershey, Pennsylvania. The 1966 team, again led by Kortan, captured fourth place at nationals. In addition, Hyde stadium was home to the Pierre Cowboys of the Basin League in the 1950s and 1960s and numerous men's amateur teams over the decades. In recent years, Legion state tournaments have been held in Hyde Stadium in 1994, 1997, 1999, 2001, 2007 and 2018.

In 2013, the Post 8 baseball program started receiving annual contributions from the late Wallace R. Halverson Trust to be used only for facility improvements. It was finally time to address many failing components of the stadium, including restrooms, seating, outfield fence and numerous issues affecting player and spectator safety. A complete renovation was designed, and the City of Pierre agreed to fund half of the \$2 million project. The renovation project, completed in 2016, included the following improvements:

Light towers, concession stand (restrooms, crawl's nest, umpire/training room, box suite), outfield fence, field drainage and sprinklers, home and visitor stadium seating, exterior fencing, batting cage, dugouts, bullpens, safety netting, ticket booth and donor memorial. All in all, Hyde stadium has become a Pierre landmark and is a unique setting in the shadow of the state Capitol building. Hyde has given the community many years of pleasant, family entertainment, and it's provided over 80 years of baseball to the Pierre community and memories to last a lifetime for several generations of young Pierre ballplayers.
